

Draft Policy on NMA Annual Membership Meeting

As directed by the Bylaws, the Annual Membership Meeting (annual meeting) is to be held once per year with any registered member being eligible to participate. The following summarizes the purpose and content of the annual meeting.

- The agenda will include, but is not limited to, the following items:
 - Time for casting votes of nominees for elected positions followed by the tallying of votes and announcement of election results (see Election Policy)
 - Business meeting including report of the President regarding activities of the NMA and report of the Secretary-Treasurer regarding the financial status of the NMA
 - Presentation and discussion of all resolutions submitted to the meeting for a vote by the membership (see Resolution Policy)
 - Presentation of NMA and NMA Foundation Awards and Scholarships as indicated
 - Installation of the President-Elect as NMA President

In addition to the specific activities above, the Annual Membership Meeting is to serve as a venue for continuing education, networking, and collaboration for members to advance the purposes of the NMA and the profession.
